Each level will have a limit on participants, but people are always moving up so there will rarely ever be a wait. As long as there is an opening you can join whenever it works best for your schedule.*

What is Levels Training?

Flexibility In Class Scheduling you get 6 classes to use over a 4 month period. You may choose to come 6 classes in a row, every other week, or 3 classes, a break and then another 3 classes, it's up to you! You never have to worry about missing a class again.

Progress At Your Own Pace you may stay in the same Level throughout your pass or you may go through several Levels if you and your pup excel. All you need is to have your instructor test you to graduate to the next level. You never have to wait until the next class to continue improving your dog's skills.
